



## **MAIN STREET ART PARKING PROTOCOL**

In order to keep all patrons of MSA safe, we ask that you read and sign this document agreeing to follow the parking and traffic flow regulations. Since our parking lot is small and our building is located near a bend in the road where the visibility is poor, this policy was developed to inform our patrons of possible traffic hazards and therefore avoid any problems.

- There are three parking spaces available to the left of the building as outlined on the pavement. There is a van accessible handicap space directly in front of the ramp. These four spaces are available for your use. If you park in the spaces in our lot facing forward, please make every effort to back up staying in our lot and then enter Route 85/Main Street facing forward. Please do not back out onto Route 85 if at all possible (see diagram).
- Patrons of MSA can park on Route 85/Main Street providing they are to the inside or on the right side of the fog line (white line). You may park in front of Badger Park, in front of the apartment building next door, and in front of the church, but not on the crosswalk. You may park across the street in front of the library (see diagram).
- Patrons of MSA can park on Swamscott and Church Streets.
- Patrons of MSA can park in the public lot at the Newfields Town Hall.
- When dropping off a student at MSA, please approach the center traveling east and using your directional pull up to the stairs and ask your student(s) to exit on the right side of the vehicle. Parents may line up to drop off or pick up students by using their directional and hugging the south side of Main Street going East (see diagram).
- When walking to MSA, please use the sidewalk on the North side of Main Street and cross at the crosswalk that is East of MSA in front of the church. Then proceed 2 blocks west to MSA. Please be aware that there isn't a sidewalk on the South side of Main Street, so be careful.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding of the MSA parking policy. It is our goal to keep our patrons and staff safe so that we may continue to enjoy our art school in the village.
